

BAIL APPLICATION

What is bail?

Bail is the conditional release of an accused person from custody while awaiting trial.

Who can apply for bail?

An accused person can apply for bail either on his own or through an attorney. A bail application should be filed before the Registrar of the High Court which will be considered by a judge of the High Court. Where the judge grants an application for bail, the accused person is given conditions which he should abide by. Failure to abide by the conditions may result in the prosecutor applying to have the bail revoked.
