

REPORTING A CRIME

Step 1:

If a crime has been committed against you or you have witnessed a crime being committed, visit the nearest police station to make a report.

Step 2:

Ensure that a statement is recorded. After the statement has been recorded, read over your statement and then place your signature. Upon that statement being recorded, the police will then investigate the matter.

Step 3:

After the investigation has been done, where it is a serious crime, the police will send the file to the DPP who will then decide whether to prosecute the matter.

Where there is sufficient evidence that a crime has been committed, the police may then proceed to place a charge against the person ("the accused") who committed the crime.
